When you lift your right hand and open it up, that is time.

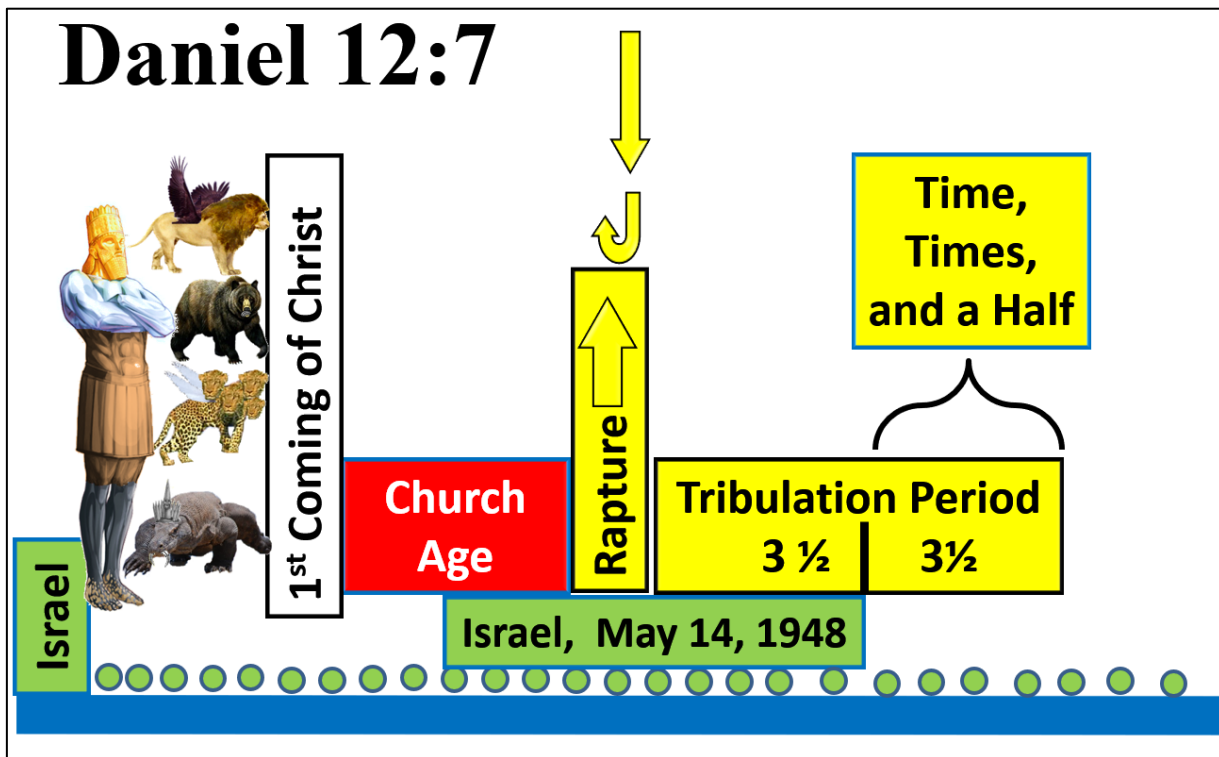
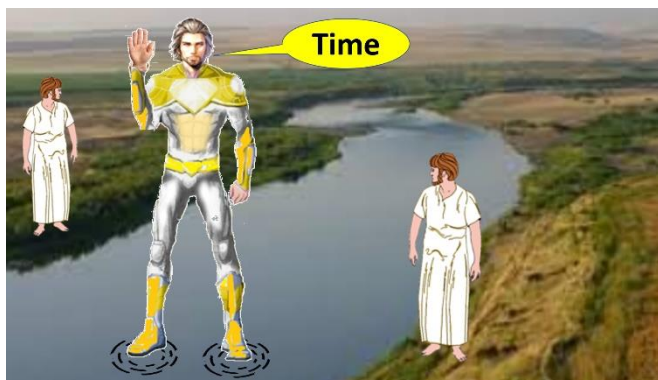


When you lift your right hand and open it up, that is time. When you lift your left hand and open it up, close it and open it again, that is times.



By keeping your right hand up, you add the times. When you lower your left hand and close your right hand, that is an half time. Three and one half.
