

## Ephesians 1:4-7

### I. Mystery of God's will.

**Ephesians 1:9** “Having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself:”

### II. God's will is that we are chosen because we are in Jesus.

**Ephesians 1:4** “According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:”

**A.** God's will is that we are chosen to be adopted.

**Q6 B.** The way you would be a child of God by adoption in Christ.

**1.** We are born again to be children of God in Christ.

**2.** We are adopted to be children of God in that we are chosen in Christ.

**Ephesians 1:6 “To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.”**
