Q9.	Israel's young whelp, a king, was taken in chains to
	2 Kings 23:33 "And Pharaohnechoh put him in bands at Riblah in the land of Hamath, that he might not reign in Jerusalem; and put the land to a tribute of an hundred talents of silver, and a talent of gold.  34 And Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and turned his name to Jehoiakim, and took Jehoahaz away: and he came to Egypt, and died there."
Q10	. Jehoahaz was taken from Jerusalem in chains to Egypt and there.
Q11	. The next king was Eliakim, and Pharaoh named him, who became Israel's second cub.
	Ezekiel 19:5 "Now when she saw that she had waited, and her hope was lost, then she took another of her whelps, and made him a young lion." Ezekiel 19:8 "Then the nations set against him on every side from the provinces, and spread their net over him: he was taken in their pit. Ezekiel 19:9 "And they put him in ward in chains, and brought him to the king of Babylon: they brought him into holds, that his voice should no more be heard upon the mountains of Israel."
