**Ezekiel 2:1 “And he said unto me, Son of man, stand upon thy feet, and I will speak unto thee.”**

**Ezekiel was called the Son of man 93 times.**

**Why was Ezekiel called the Son of man?**

**To let him know that after being in the presence of the Heavenly host and God, he is not one of them.**

**Genesis 2:7 “And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.”**

**Psalm 8:4 “What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?**

**5 For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour.”**

**Psalm 121:2 “My help *cometh* from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.”**

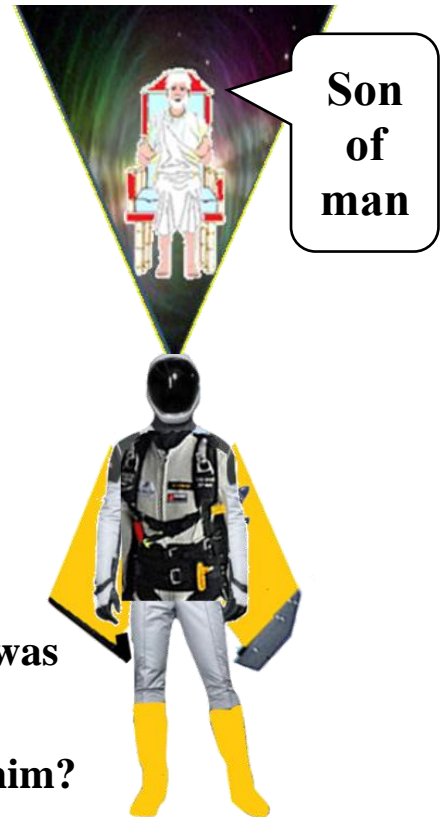
**Q4. To let him know that he is limited and needs God’s \_\_\_\_\_.**

**Why did Jesus use the title Son of man?**

**Galatians 4:4 “But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,**

**5 To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.”**



Isaiah 7:14 “Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.”

Q5. To show that He came to this earth through a \_\_\_\_\_.

1 Corinthians 15:42 “So also *is* the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption:”

Q6. To show that Jesus would change our earthy, terrestrial body to a heavenly, celestial body by His \_\_\_\_\_.

Ezekiel 2:3 “And he said unto me, Son of man, I send thee to the children of Israel, to a rebellious nation that hath rebelled against me: they and their fathers have transgressed against me, *even* unto this very day.”

Ezekiel 2:4 “For *they are* impudent children and stiffhearted. I do send thee unto them; and thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD.”

“Thus saith the Lord” is used 126 times in Ezekiel and 147 times in Jeremiah.
