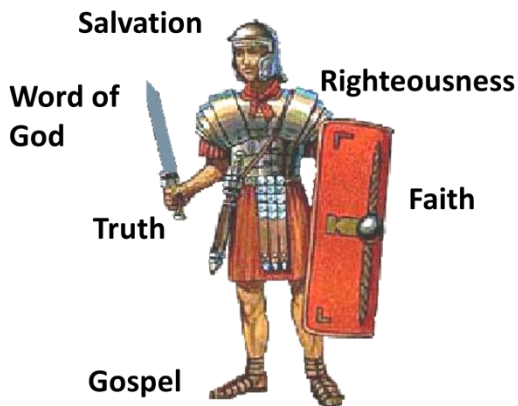


# “Defeating The Enemy”
