B. A total of seventy Hebrews are in Egypt. Vs. 5

C. The children of Israel (Hebrews) increased abundantly. Vs. 6-7

II. Israel oppressed by a new king of Egypt. Vs. 8-22

A. The new king did not know Joseph. Vs. 8

B. The new king enslaved the children of Israel. Vs. 9-14
