

Exodus 14

- I. God gave instructions to Moses about where to camp. Vs. 1-4**
 - A. They were to camp by the Red Sea. Vs. 2**
 - B. Pharaoh would think the Israelites were trapped in the wilderness. Vs. 3**
 - C. God would harden Pharaoh's heart that he might destroy Pharaoh's army. Vs. 4**
- II. Pharaoh goes after Israel. Vs. 5-9**
 - A. Pharaoh takes 600 chosen chariots with captains. Vs. 7**
- III. The Israelites were afraid. Vs. 10-14**
- IV. God instructed Moses to stretch his rod over the Red Sea and go forward. Vs. 15-18**
- V. The pillar of cloud and the angel of God that was before the camp, removed and went behind them. Vs. 19-20**
 - A. The pillar of cloud was darkness to the Egyptians and light to the Israelites all night. Vs. 20**
- VI. The Israelites crossed the Red Sea on dry land. Vs. 21-22**
 - A. God divided the Red Sea with a strong east wind all night. Vs. 21**
 - B. The Israelites went on dry ground in the midst of the sea. Vs. 22**
 - C. The waters were a wall unto them on each side. Vs. 22**
 - D. The Baptism of the Red Sea. 1 Corinthians 10:1-6**
- VII. The Egyptians pursued them into the Red Sea. Vs. 23-25**
- VIII. God instructed Moses to stretch his rod over the Red Sea for the waters to return and destroy the Egyptians. Vs. 26-28**
- IX. God saved Israel out of the hand of the Egyptians. Vs. 29-31**
