I. Garments for the priests. Vs. 1-3 A. The garments are for glory and beauty. Vs. 1-2

II. The garments are to be made. Vs. 4-5


- A. Breastplate. Vs. 4
- B. Ephod. Vs. 4
- C. Robe. Vs. 4
- D. Coat. Vs. 4
- E. Mitre. Vs. 4
- F. Girdle. Vs. 4
- G. They shall be made of gold, blue, purple, scarlet and fine linen. Vs. 5
 - 1. All these colors are symbolic of Christ.
 - 2. Jesus is our high Priest. Hebrews 3:1; 4:14; 6:20
- **III. The Ephod. Vs. 6-7, 9-14**
 - A. The ephod is to be made of gold. blue, purple, scarlet and fine linen. Vs. 6
 - B. It is to have two shoulder pieces. Vs. 7
 - C. Each shoulder piece is to have an onyx stone on it. Vs. 9
 - D. Each stone is to be engraved with six names of the 12 tribes of Israel. Vs. 10-13

E. A chain of gold is to be attached to each of the shoulder piece. Vs. 14 IV. The Girdle. Vs. 8

A. It is to be be made of gold. blue, purple, scarlet and fine linen.

- V. The Breastplate. Vs. 15-30
 - A. The breastplate of judgment is to be made of gold. blue, purple, scarlet and fine linen. Vs. 15
 - B. It is to be 9 inches (span) square and doubled. Vs. 16
 - C. It is to have four rows of three stones, one for each of the 12 tribes of Israel. Vs. 17-20

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- D. Each stone is to be engraved with a name of the 12 tribes of Israel. Vs. 16-21
- E. The two chains connected to the shoulder piece are to be connected to two rings at the top corners of the breastplate. Vs. 22-25
- F. The two rings at the bottom of the breastplate are to be connected to the two rings one on each side of the ephod by a blue lace. Vs. 26-28
- G. The breastplate is to be worn over Aaron's heart for a memorial. Vs. 29
- H. The Urim and Thummim are to be placed in the breastplate. Vs. 30
- **VI. The Robe. Vs. 31-35**
 - A. The robe is to be the color blue. Vs. 31
 - B. The robe is to have a hole in the top for the head to go through. Vs. 32
 - C. On the hem at the bottom it is to have pomegranates of blue, purple, and scarlet all around with a gold bell between each one. Vs. 33-35

VII. The Mitre. Vs. 36-39

- A. The mitre, a turban, is to have a pure gold plate with the inscription "Holiness to the Lord" on it. Vs. 36-38
- B. The mitre is to be of fine linen. Vs. 39
- VIII. The Coat. Vs. 39-43
 - A. The coat is to be of fine linen. Vs. 39
 - B. The coat is to be for glory and beauty. Vs. 40
 - C. The coat is to be worn in all the services of the tabernacle. Vs. 41-43
