 - G. They are to offer a bullock for a sin offering. Vs. 10-14**
 - H. They are to offer the first ram for a burnt offering. Vs. 15-18**
 - I. They are to offer the second ram for consecration of Aaron and his sons. Vs. 19-22**
 - J. They are to offer a loaf, a cake, and a wafer or thin cake, for a wave offering. Vs. 23-25**
 - K. They are to offer the breast of the ram as a wave offering. Vs. 26**
 - L. They are to offer the shoulder of the ram as a heave offering. Vs. 27-28**
 - M. Aaron's vestments are to descend to his son, who shall succeed him. Vs. 29-30**
 - N. Aaron and his sons are to eat the flesh of the ram of consecration and bread that is in the basket. Vs. 31-32**
 - O. A stranger is not to eat of it. Vs. 33**
 - P. If anything is left till the morning, it is to be burnt with fire. Vs. 34**

Q. The dedication of Aaron and his sons are to last for seven days. Vs. 35

**R. A bullock is to be offered for a sin offering each day for seven days.
Vs. 36-37**

**S. Two lambs, one for the morning and the other for the evening
sacrifice, are to be offered continually. Vs. 38-42**
