I. Moses saw the burning bush. Vs. 1-3

A. Moses led the flock of sheep to Mount Horeb. Vs. 1

B. The angel of the Lord appeared unto him. Vs. 2

1. In a flame of fire.

2. In a bush on fire, but not consumed.

C. Moses turned to see why the bush was not consumed by the fire. Vs. 3

II. God spoke to Moses. Vs. 4-10

A. God called Moses by name. Vs. 4

B. God told Moses to take off his shoes because he was standing on holy ground. Vs. 5

C. God identified himself as the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Vs. 6

D. Moses hid his face. Vs. 6

E. God told Moses that he would deliver the Israelites out of Egypt to a land flowing with milk and honey. Vs. 7-8

F. God commissioned Moses to deliver Israel out Egypt. Vs. 9-10

III. Moses answered God. Vs. 11-14

- A. Moses said “Who am I, that I should go unto Pharaoh, and that I should bring forth the children of Israel out of Egypt?”

- B. God told Moses that He would be with him. Vs. 12**
- C. God told Moses that he would serve him on Mount Horeb.
Vs. 12**
- D. Moses wanted to know God’s name. Vs. 13**
- E. God told Moses his name is I AM THAT I AM. Vs. 14**

IV. God told Moses what would happen. Vs. 15-22

- A. Moses would tell the children of Israel that God has sent him.
Vs. 15-17**
- B. The people would listen to Moses. Vs. 18**
- C. Moses and the elders would ask Pharaoh to let them go to the wilderness for three days to sacrifice to God. Vs. 18**
- D. Pharaoh would not let them go. Vs. 19**
- E. God would force Pharaoh to let the children of Israel go.
Vs. 20**
- F. The Egyptians would give their jewels of silver and gold, and raiment to the children of Israel. Vs. 21-22**
