
I. Bezaleel and Aholiab made the priestly vestments. Vs. 1

II. Bezaleel and Aholiab made the vestments for the High Priest.

Vs. 2-26

A. They made the ephod Vs. 2-4, 6-7

- 1. They made the ephod of gold, blue, purple, scarlet and fine linen. Vs. 2-3
- 2. They made two shoulderpieces. Vs. 4
- 3. They put an onyx stone on each shoulder. Vs. 6
- 4. They engraved each stone with six names of the 12 tribes of Israel. Vs. 6-7
- 5. The four colors are symbolic of Jesus, our high Priest. Hebrews 3:1; 4:14; 6:20
- B. They made the girdle. Vs. 5
- C. They made the breastplate. Vs. 8-21
 - 1. They made the breastplate of judgment of gold, blue, purple, scarlet and fine linen. Vs. 8
 - 2. They made it 9 inches (span) square and doubled. Vs. 9
 - 3. They made four rows of three stones, one stone for each of the 12 tribes of Israel. Vs. 10-14
 - 4. They engraved each stone with a name of the 12 tribes of Israel. Vs. 14
 - 5. They made two chains and connected them to the shoulder piece by two rings at the top corners of the breastplate. Vs. 15-18

- 6. They connected two rings at the bottom of the breastplate to the two rings one on each side of the ephod by a blue lace. Vs. 19-21
- D. They made the robe. Vs. 22-26
 - 1. They made the robe blue. Vs. 22
 - 2. They made a hole in the top for the head to go through. Vs. 23
 - 3. They made the hem at the bottom with pomegranates of blue, purple, and scarlet all around with a gold bell between each one. Vs. 24-26
- III. Bezaleel and Aholiab made the vestments for Aaron and his sons. Vs. 27-31
 - A. They made the coats of fine linen. Vs. 27
 - B. They made a mitre, a turban, of fine linen. Vs. 28
 - 1. They made it with a pure gold plate with the inscription "Holiness to the Lord" on it. Vs. 28-31
 - C. They made the girdle. Vs. 29
- IV. Bezaleel and Aholiab brought the completed Tabernacle to Moses. Vs. 32-43
 - A. The tent is the Tabernacle. Vs. 32-33
 - 1. The tent is referred to as a male by the word "his". Vs. 33
 - 2. The tent, Tabernacle, is Jesus, the son of God.
 - 3. They brought all his furniture, his taches, his boards, his bars, his pillars and his sockets. Vs. 33
 - 4. They brought the coverings. Vs. 34
 - 5. They brought the ark of the testimony. Vs. 35
 - 6. They brought the table. Vs. 36
 - 7. They brought the pure candlestick. Vs. 37
 - 8. They brought the golden altar. Vs. 38
 - 9. They brought the hanging for the Tabernacle door. Vs. 38
 - 10. They brought the brass altar. Vs. 39
 - 11. They brought the hangings of the court. Vs. 40
 - 12. They brought the clothes of service. Vs. 41
- V. Moses blessed them. Vs. 42-43
