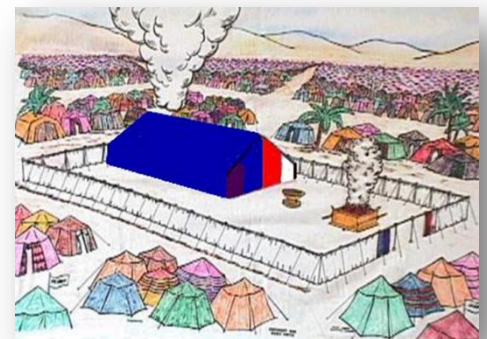
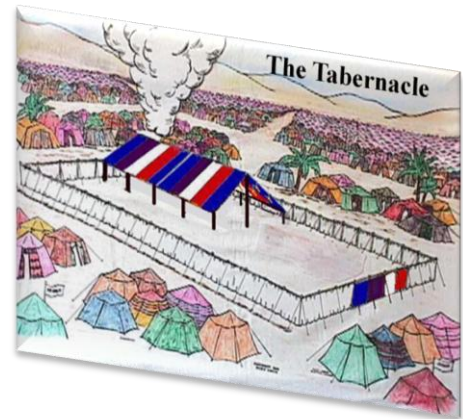


Exodus 40

I. God tells Moses how to set up the Tabernacle. Vs. 1-15

- A. On the first day of the first month the Tabernacle is to be set up. Vs. 2
- B. The tent is to be set up. Vs. 2
- C. The ark of the testimony is to be covered by veil and to be set under the tent. Vs. 3
- D. The table is to be brought in with the showbread in order. Vs. 4
- E. The Candlestick is to be brought in and lit. Vs. 4
- F. The altar of gold is to be brought in, and incense is to be burnt. Vs. 5
- G. The veil, door of the Tabernacle, is to be hung. Vs. 5
- H. The brass altar is to be placed before the door of the Tabernacle. Vs. 6
- I. The laver is to be placed between the brass altar and the door of the Tabernacle. Vs. 7
- J. The court is to be set up. Vs. 8
- K. Everything is to be anointed with the anointing oil. Vs. 9-11
- L. Aaron and his sons are to be washed with water before the door of the Tabernacle. Vs. 12
- M. Aaron and his sons are to be clothed in holy garments and anointed. Vs. 13-15



II. Moses sets up the Tabernacle. Vs. 17-33

- A. Moses set up the tent, the Tabernacle, on the first day of the first month in the second year after they left Egypt. Vs. 17
- B. Moses put the boards, bars and pillars in place. Vs. 18

- C. Moses put the coverings over the tent, the Tabernacle. Vs. 19**
- D. Moses put the staves on the ark and placed it in the Holy of Holies behind the veil. Vs. 20-21**
- E. Moses put the table on the north side in the Holy Place and put the bread in order upon it. Vs. 22-23**
- F. Moses put the candlestick on the south side in the Holy Place and lit the lamps. Vs. 24-25**
- G. Moses put the golden altar on west side before the veil in the Holy Place and burnt sweet incense thereon. Vs. 26-27**
- H. Moses hanged the veil up for the door of the Tabernacle. Vs. 28**
- I. Moses put the brass altar in front of the door of the tent, the Tabernacle, and offered burnt offering and meat offering on it. Vs. 29**
- J. Moses put the laver between the tent and the brass altar with water in it, and Moses, Aaron and his sons washed their hands and feet. Vs. 30-32**
- K. Moses set up the court and court gate around the Tabernacle. Vs. 33**

III. The glory of God filled the Tabernacle. Vs. 34-38

- A. A cloud covered the tent, the Tabernacle, and the glory of God filled the Tabernacle. Vs. 34**
- B. Moses was not able to enter the tent because the glory of God filled it. Vs. 35**
- C. When the cloud was taken up off the Tabernacle, the people followed it. Vs. 36**
- D. When the cloud was on the Tabernacle, the people stayed. Vs. 37**
- E. In the day time it was a cloud, and at night it was a pillar of fire. Vs. 38**
