## Exodus 6

### I. The covenant is renewed with Moses. Vs. 1-13

A. Now Pharaoh will see the power of God. Vs. 1

B. God tells Moses that He is the Lord (Jehovah). Vs. 2

1. To know God by his name “Lord” - JEHOVAH is to experience the fulfillment of his covenant.

C. Abraham, Isaac and Jacob had known God by the name “El Shaddai” - God Almighty. Vs. 3

1. To know God by his name “El Shaddai” - God Almighty is to experience his provision and protection.
2. They experienced his continual provision and constant protection.

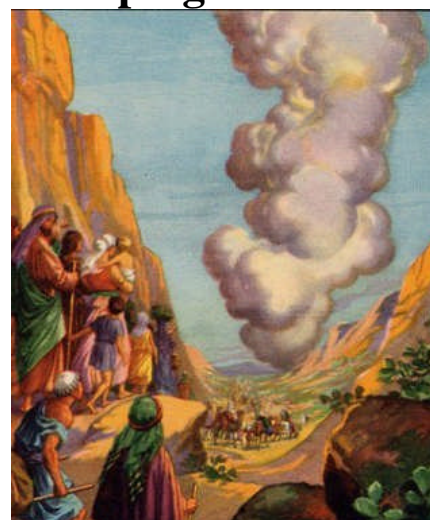
D. They had not known God by the name JEHOVAH. Vs. 3

1. Because they had not experienced God keeping his covenant.

E. Moses and Israel will know God by his name JEHOVAH because they will experience God keeping his covenant. Vs. 4-8

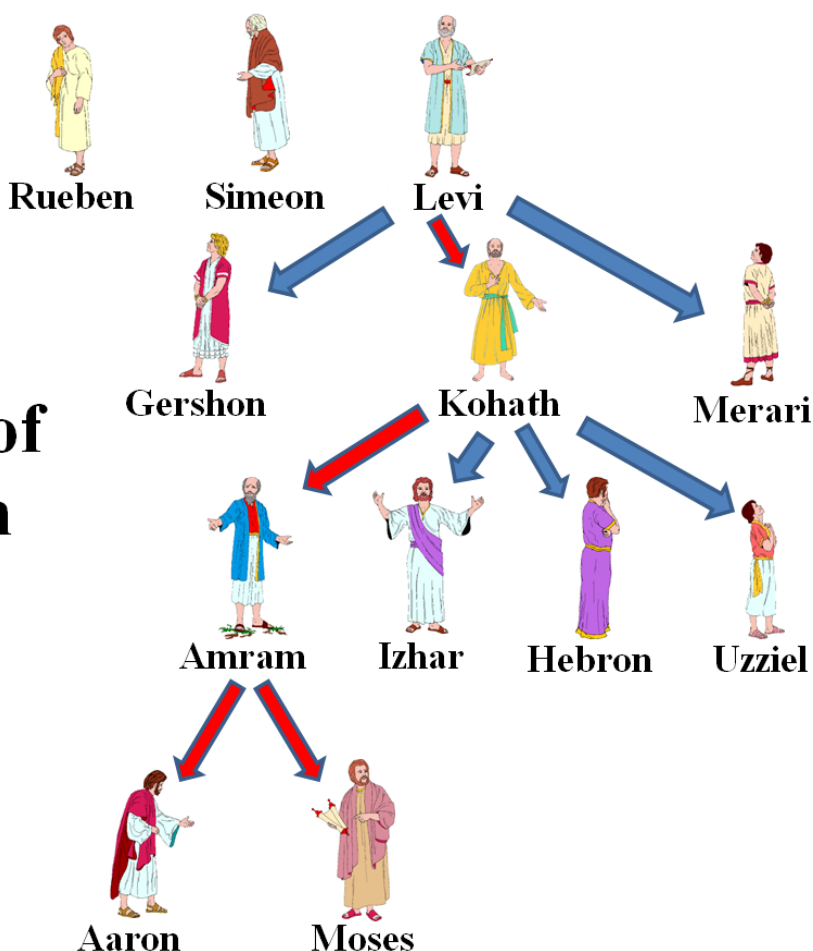
