**E. Moses asked Pharaoh when he wanted the frogs to be taken away. Vs. 9-11**

**1. Pharaoh said "tomorrow". Vs. 10**

**F. Moses prayed that the frogs would be taken away tomorrow. Vs. 12-14**

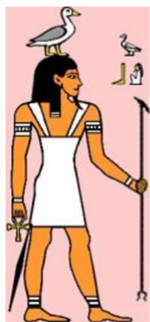
**1. God removed the frogs the next day. Vs. 13**

**E. Pharaoh would let the people go if the flies were removed. Vs. 26-29**

**F. Moses prays to God, and the flies were taken away. Vs.30-31**

**G. Pharaoh hardened his heart and did not let the people go.
