

## **Exodus 9**

- A. Moses told Pharaoh to let the people go or God would smite the Egyptian livestock. Vs. 1-3
- B. The livestock of Israel would be spared. Vs. 4
- C. On the next day the livestock of the Egyptians died. Vs. 5-6
- D. None of the livestock of Israel died. Vs. 6
- E. Pharaoh's heart was hardened. Vs. 7
- II. The sixth plague: Boils. Vs. 8-12




- A. God told Moses to throw handfuls of ashes of the furnace in the air before Pharaoh. Vs. 8
- B. The ashes would turn to boils upon the Egyptians and their animals. Vs. 9-10
- C. Pharaoh's magicians were affected by the boils. Vs. 11

## D. The Lord hardened the heart of Pharaoh. Vs. 12

## III. The seventh plague: Hail. Vs. 13-35



- A. God sent Moses to Pharaoh early in the morning. Vs. 13
- B. If Pharaoh did not let the people go, God would rain hail and fire upon Egypt except where the children of God were. Vs. 13-21
- C. God rained hail and fire upon Egypt except where the children of God were. Vs. 22-26
- D. Pharaoh called for Moses and Aaron. Vs. 27
- E. Pharaoh would let the people go if the hail and fire stopped. Vs. 27-32
- F. Moses prayed to God, and the hail and fire ceased. Vs. 33
- G. Pharaoh hardened his heart and did not let the people go. Vs. 34-35
