2. Paul received visions and revelations of the Lord. Vs. 1
  3. Paul knew a man in Christ about 14 years ago. Vs. 2
  4. Paul did not know whether the man in Christ had a physical body or not. Vs. 2-3
  5. The man in Christ was caught up to the third heaven. Vs. 2
  6. The man in Christ “was caught up into paradise, and heard unspeakable words, which it is not lawful for a man to utter.” Vs. 4
  7. Paul will only give glory to the man in Christ. Vs. 5-6
  8. The man in Christ taught Paul the mysteries of God. Vs. 7
  9. God gave Paul a thorn in the flesh to keep him humble. Vs. 7
  10. The thorn in the flesh is the messenger of Satan. Vs. 7
- G. After three years, Paul returns to Damascus and goes to Jerusalem. Vs. 17-18
- H. Paul only talked to Peter for 15 days. Vs. 18
- I. Paul also saw James, the Lord’s brother. Vs. 19
- J. Paul is telling the truth. Vs. 20
- K. After seeing Peter and James, Paul goes to the regions of Syria and Cilicia. Vs. 21
- L. The churches in Judea glorified God because of the preaching of Christ by Paul, even though they had not seen Paul. Vs. 22-24
