- I. Faith. Hebrews 11:1
- II. How did the people know the Word of God in order to have faith? Hebrews 11:2
 - A. Examples of those who had faith in the spoken word of God.
 - 1. Isaac believed what God told Abraham. Hebrews 11:20
 - a. Abraham would have a great nation. Genesis 12:1-2
 - b. Those who blessed Abraham would be blessed and those who cursed Abraham would be cursed. Genesis 12:3
 - 2. By faith Isaac would pass God's blessing on. Hebrews 11:20
 - a. Abraham wanted Ishmael to have the blessing instead of Isaac. Genesis 17:18-21
 - b. Isaac wanted Esau to have the blessing instead of Jacob. Genesis 25:28, Genesis 27:1-4
 - c. Abraham had faith that God would do the right thing with Isaac.
 - d. Isaac had faith that God would have him to bless the right son. Genesis 27:5-40
 - 3. By faith Jacob would honor the birthright as God gave it to Joseph. Hebrews 11:21 1 Chronicles 5:1
 - a. Joseph would have the doubled portion of the birthright in the Promised Land through his two sons. Genesis 48:8-22
 - 4. By faith Joseph wanted his bones to be buried in the Promised Land as he had faith that God would deliver the children of Israel out of Egypt. Hebrews 11:22 Genesis 50:24-25
