 - A. Examples of those who had faith in the spoken word of God.
 - 1. The faith of Moses' parents. Hebrews 11:23
 - a. Why did Moses' parents hide Moses?
 - 1) Because he was a proper child.
 - a) The Greek word, asteios (proper child) was used. Asteios means:
 - ✓ of polished manners
 - ✓ elegant (of body)
 - ✓ comely
 - ✓ fair
 - b) In Exodus 2:2 the Hebrew word towb (goodly child) was used and it means:
 - ✓ pleasant, agrrable (to the senses)
 - ✓ pleasant (to the higher nature)
 - ✓ good, excellent (of its kind)
 - ✓ glad, happy, prosperous (of man's sensuous nature)
 - **✓** good understanding (of man's intellectual nature)
 - b. Only by faith would this proper child
 - ✓ be raised and educated in Pharaoh's court. Acts 7:22
 - ✓ be used to deliver Israel out of Egypt. Acts 7:34-36
 - ✓ be used to organize and develop Israel into a great nation.
 - ✓ be one of the two anointed ones that stand before the Lord of the whole earth. Zechariah 4:11-14, Luke 9:28-31
