- I. Faith. Hebrews 11:1
- II. How did the people know the Word of God in order to have faith? Hebrews 11:2
  - A. At first the word of God was spoken. Hebrews 1:1-2
    - 1. It was passed from one generation to another by repeating God' spoken word.
    - 2. Examples of those who had faith in the spoken word of God.
      - a. Able. Hebrews 11:4
      - b. Enoch. Hebrews 11:5
      - c. Noah. Hebrews 11:7
        - 1) How did Noah know the word of God in order to have faith in it?
          - a) Probably by Adam and then by God. Genesis 6-8
      - d. Abraham and Sarah. Hebrews 11:8-12
        - 1) Abraham followed God. Genesis 12:1
          - a) First went to Haran with his Father. Genesis 11:31
        - 2) God promised Abraham that he would be a great nation. Genesis 12:2
          - a) All the nations of the Earth would be blessed. Genesis 12:3

- 3) Abraham left Haran at the age of 75. Genesis 12:4
- 4) Abraham went to the land of the Canaanites. Genesis 12:5-6
- 5) God promised this land to Abraham and his seed. Genesis 12:7
  - a) Abraham's seed is Christ. Galatians 3:16
- 6) Abraham was a sojourner and a stranger in Canaan. Genesis 12:8, Hebrews 11:9
- 7) Sarah had faith in God. Hebrews 11:11-12
  - a) Sarah will be a mother of Nations. Genesis 17:15-16
  - b) Abraham will be 100 years old and Sarah 90 years old when Isaac is born. Genesis 17:17, 18:9-13
  - c) Is anything too hard for the Lord? Genesis 18:14-15
- c. Abraham looked for a city made by God. Hebrews 11:10
  - 1) Looking for a city to come. Hebrews 13:14
  - 2) In my Father's house. John 14:2
  - 3) They were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. Hebrews 11:13
    - a) Looking and desiring a heavenly country. Hebrews 11:14-16



- b) Jerusalem will be restored. Isaiah 2:2-5, Isaiah 65:18-25
- c) New Jerusalem. Revelation 21-22
