IV. We have an altar. Hebrews 13:10-13

- A. The use of altars in the Old Testament.
 - 1. Altars were built to honor God and to let those in the area know that you worship God.
 - 2. First recorded altar was that of Noah giving thanks to God. Genesis 8:20-21
 - 3. Elijah built an altar to show the power of God by fire. 1 Kings 18:21-24, 31-39
- B. The Israelites were to build two altars.
 - 1. The brazen altar for the tabernacle and later the temple. Exodus 27:1-8
 - a. Sacrifices were made daily. Hebrews 10:11
 - 2. The golden altar of incense for the holy place in the tabernacle and later the temple. Exodus 30:1-10
- C. The Israelites had their altars and we have an altar. Hebrews 13:10
 - 1. We Whosoever Anyone. John 3:16, Romans 10:13-15
 - 2. Our altar is outside the camp. Hebrews 13:11-13
 - 3. Our altar is the Cross.
 - 4. The sacrifice was Jesus. Once for all. Hebrews 10:10
 - 5. One sacrifice for sins forever. Hebrews 10:11-12
