2. A wall with 12 gates around it. Revelation 21:12

a. Each gate was one pearl. Revelation 21:21

b. Each gate had a name of one of the 12 tribes of Israel. Revelation 21:12-13

c. The wall had 12 foundations and garnished with precious stones.

3. The city is 12 thousand furlongs (1,500 miles) wide, long and high. Revelation 21:16

4. The wall is 144 cubits (250 feet) high. Revelation 21:17

5. The wall is Jasper. Revelation 21:18

6. The city and the street are pure gold, transparent as glass. Revelation 21:18, 21

7. No temple in the city. Revelation 21:22

8. The glory of God and the Lamb are the light of it. Revelation 21:23

9. The Holy Trinity, Israel and the Church live inside the city. Revelation 21:3, 9, 12

10. The rest of the saved live outside the city on the new Earth. Revelation 21:24-27

a. They are organized into nations with kings. Revelation 21:24
