Hebrews 2:1

A. If Jesus and the Bible do not have top priority....

1. You will forget and let them slip by.

James 1:22-25
Matthew 16:5-12

2. Your life will be overcharged with other things. Luke 21:34
3. You will love pleasures more than God. 2 Timothy 3:4-5
4. You will turn to fables. 2 Timothy 4:2-5
- a) The Bible is not a fable. 2 Peter 1:16-21

Now with the completion of the Bible we know that it is not a collection of writings about God, but in truth God's holy words. TAKE EARNEST HEED!
