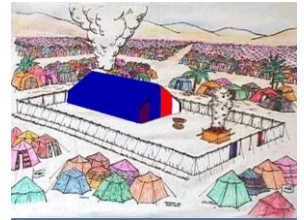
I. Jesus is greater than Moses.

Hebrews 3:2-6

A. Jesus and Moses were both faithful in their house.

Hebrews 3:2

1. House of Moses, the nation of Israel.
Exodus 19:3



2. House of Jesus, a church.
1 Timothy 3:15



A church building is the clothing of the church, the people.

- B. Jesus built his house (a Church) and everything else.
Hebrews 3:3-4



1. Built His house (a Church) upon the rock.
2. An holy temple in the Lord.
3. A spiritual house.
4. Creator of all.
