I. God's Rest.

A. Rest in the house of Moses (Nation of Israel). Hebrews 3:7-11, 15-19

B. Rest in the house of Jesus (Churches). Hebrews 3:12-15, 4:1-11

II. Rest in the house of Moses (Nation of Israel). Hebrews 3:7-11, 15-19

A. "Rest" is the land of Canaan,
the promise land. Genesis 17:8, 1 Kings 8:56

B. The house of Moses could have entered into the rest of God,
the promise land after a year and two months. Numbers 1:1

C. Some of them could not enter into the rest of God
because of unbelief. (Unbelief is disobeying God.) Hebrews 3:19
Psalms 95:7-11

1. When they heard the voice of God they would not listen. Hebrews 3:7

2. They harden their hearts. Hebrews 3:8

3. They ignored God's works. Hebrews 3:9

4. They did not want to know God's ways. Hebrews 3:10

5. God was not upset because of the mixed multitudes. Hebrews 3:16
Exodus 12:38

6. God was upset with the Israelites because of their sins. Hebrews 3:17-19

III. Rest in the house of Jesus (Churches).

A. "Rest" is to allow Jesus to live through us.
