- a. Babes in Christ. 1 Corinthians 3:1-3**
- 2. Adults teach strong meat and are skillful in the word of God. Hebrews 5:14**
- a. Become adults in the Word. 1 Corinthians 13:11**
- b. Receive the gifts of Christ. Ephesians 4:11-14**
