1. The Tent, symbolic of Jesus.

a. The color blue symbolic of Jesus from above. John 3:31

b. The color scarlet symbolic of the blood of Jesus Matthew 26:28

c. The color white symbolic of the righteousness of Jesus.

Romans 3:26

d. The color purple symbolic of the Kingship of Jesus 1 Timothy 6:15

2. The boards symbolic of the churches.

Ephesians 2:20-22

3. The three coverings of the Tabernacle.

a. Curtain of goats' hair, black.

Exodus 26:7

1) Symbolic of our sins laid on Jesus.

1 Peter 2:24

b. Curtain of rams' skins dyed red.

Exodus 26:14

1) Symbolic of the blood of Jesus covering our sins.

Matthew 26:28

a) For forgiveness of sins.

Ephesians 1:7

c. Curtain of badgers' skins, blue.

Exodus 26:14

1) Symbolic of the heavenly origin

John 3:21

2) Symbolic of the ascension of Jesus.

Luke 24:51

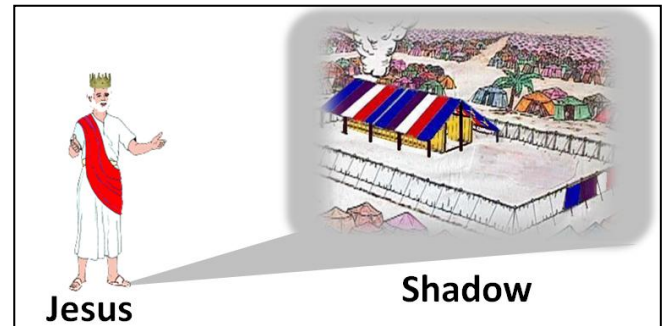
4. The candlestick.

a. Symbolic of Jesus as the light of the world.

John 8:12

5. The table of shewbread symbolic of Jesus as the bread of life. John 6:35



6. The altar of Incense symbolic of Jesus interceding for us. Romans 8:34
7. The first room is the Holy Place or Sanctuary. Hebrews 9:2
8. The second room is the Holy of Holies. Hebrews 9:3
 - a. The ark of the covenant. Hebrews 9:4
 - 1) Symbolic of the death of Jesus. Exodus 25:22; 26:33
 - 2) Golden pot of manna inside the ark. Hebrews 9:4
 - a) Symbolic of Jesus as the bread of life. John 6:32
 - 3) Aaron's rod inside the ark. Hebrews 9:4
 - a) Symbolic of Jesus appointed as High Priest. Hebrews 5:4
 - 4) Ten Commandments inside the ark. Hebrews 9:4
 - a) Symbolic of Jesus as the Word of God. Revelation 19:13
 - b. The mercyseat. Hebrews 9:5
9. The priest served in the first room. Hebrews 9:6
10. The High Priest served in the second room. Hebrews 9:7
11. The Holy Ghost teaching the way into the Holiest was not yet revealed. Hebrews 9:8-10
 - a. Jesus revealed the way on the cross. Matthew 27:50-51
