

## Hebrews 9:12-26

- I. Jesus has entered into the Holy Place. Hebrews 9:12
  - A. By his own blood. Hebrews 9:12
    - 1. If the blood of animals set aside human bodies to be used of God. Hebrews 9:13
    - 2. How much more shall the blood of Christ do for us? Hebrews 9:14



- a. Purge your conscience. Hebrews 9:14
  - 1) Your conscience can be weak. 1 Corinthians 8:7
  - 2) Your conscience can be defiled. Titus 1:15
  - 3) Your conscience can be evil. Hebrews 10:22
  - 4) Your conscience can be seared with a hot iron. 1 Timothy 4:2
- b. Your conscience is a carnal mind. Romans 8:5-10
  - 1) Do not let your conscience be your guide.
- c. From dead works to serve the living God. Hebrews 9:14
  - 1) You served sin, now you can serve God. Romans 6:16-22
- **B.** Having obtained eternal redemption for us. Hebrews 9:12

II. When and how did Jesus obtain eternal redemption for us?

A. Jesus did not go into the Holy Place to obtain eternal redemption.

- 1. Jesus already had (having obtained) eternal redemption for us as he went into the Holy Place.
- B. Jesus obtained redemption at the cross by his blood and made it eternal by his resurrection.
  - 1. Redeemed us from the curse. Galatians 3:13
  - 2. Redeemed us through his blood. Ephesians 1:7, Colossians 1:14, 1 Peter 1:18-19
  - 3. Redeemed us by giving himself for us. Titus 2:13-14
  - 4. Jesus is alive for evermore. Revelation 1:18
  - 5. We are eternal by his resurrection. Romans 6:8-11
- III. In the testament (will) of Jesus is eternal redemption. Hebrews 9:15-26





- A. That testament (will) became effective when He died. Hebrews 9:16-17
- B. That testament (will) was sealed, signed, by his blood. Hebrews 9:18-26
- C. By his resurrection we experience some of that testament (will) now and have full assurance that we will experience all of it with Him. Romans 6:4-7
- D. Who are in the testament (will) of Jesus?
  - 1. Those whose names are in the Lamb's Book of Life. Revelation 21:27
  - 2. Is your name written in the Lamb's Book of Life? Luke 10:20
  - 3. Have you confessed Jesus as Lord? Romans 10:8-11
