I. Appointed unto men once to die. Hebrews 9:27

- A. Can you change your appointed time to die?
 - 1. Your days are determined. Job 14:5
 - 2. You could die before your time. Ecclesiastes 7:17
 - a. By lying & stealing from God. Acts 5:1-11
 - b. By being unfruitful. Luke 13:6-9
 - c. By a sinful life. Proverbs 10:27
 - 3. You can extend your time. Proverbs 10:27
 a. By keeping God's commandments. Proverbs 3:1-2
 b. By praying. 2 Kings 20:1-7
 - B. Would God change your appointed time to die?
 - 1. Because of the evil to come. Isaiah 57:1-2
- II. This verse does not mention an appointed time, but just that men are appointed to die. Hebrews 9:27
- III. To die does not mean to cease to exist. Hebrews 9:27
 - A. If it did, then there would be no judgment afterwards.
- IV. When is a person dead?
 - A. When the Soul and Spirit of a person leaves the physical body, then that physical body is considered dead by the Bible. Genesis 35:18
- V. The creation of a human.
 - A. When a human is created, it is a trinity of Soul, Spirit and Flesh.

1 Thessalonians 5:23

1. At the time of conception, the Soul and Spirit are created.


Psalm 139:14-16

- 2. During the first nine months the body is developed.
 - a. The body is the clothing for the Soul. 2 Corinthians 5:1-5
- 3. After the physical birth, you have the physical growth.

- VI. Then it is appointed unto men once to die. Hebrews 9:27
 - A. There is a physical death of the body.
 - 1. When people have a physical death. Luke 16:19-31
 - a. Their Soul and Spirit leaves their body.
 - 1) The Soul and Spirit of the saved leaves the body and is taken to Heaven by the Angels. Luke 16:22
 - 2) The Soul and Spirit of the lost leaves the body and goes immediately to Hell. Luke 16:22-23
 - b. Their bodies are buried. Luke 16:22
 - c. Their Soul and Spirit are still alive. Luke 16:22-31
 - **B.** There is a spiritual death.
 - 1. Everyone is spiritually dead in their sins. Ephesians 2:1,
 - 2 Corinthians 5:14
 - a. You will die in your sins. John 8:24, John 3:18
 - 2. All the lost, who are already spiritually dead, will die a physical death.
 - 3. The saved died when they were saved. Romans 6:1-14
 - a. Therefore the saved that are alive at the time of the Rapture, will not have to die physically. 1 Corinthians 15:51-58
 - 4. If you could lose your salvation, then you would need to die spiritually the second time. But you can only die once. Hebrews 9:27
- VII. "But after this the judgment." Hebrews 9:27
 - A. Only the saved will be judged at the Judgment Seat of Christ. 2 Corinthians 5:10

1. This judgment will be after the Rapture in Heaven. 2 Timothy 4:1

- B. Only the lost will be judged at the Great White Throne Judgment. Revelation 20:11-15
 - 1. This judgment will be at the end of the World. Revelation 20:11
