

Prophecies of Isaiah 35

Isaiah 30:8 – Isaiah is to write the prophecies in a book.

1. Isaiah 35:1 – The desert shall blossom as the rose when Israel is restored.



“The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose.

2. Isaiah 35:5-6 - The Messiah would heal all people.



“Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.

6 Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert.”

Matthew 15:30-31 “And great multitudes came unto him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus’ feet; and he healed them:

31 Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.”

3. Isaiah 35:7 – The land of Israel will be restored.

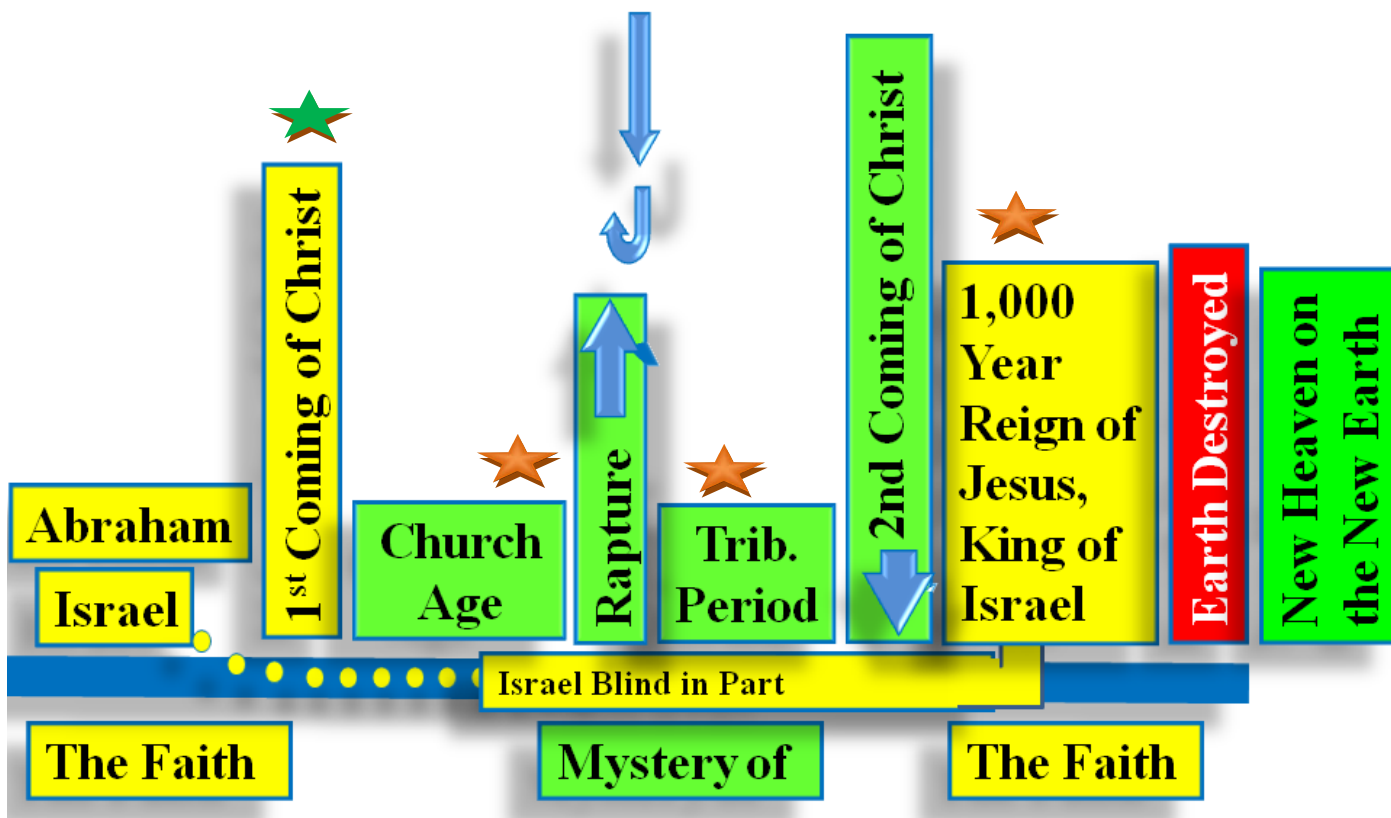


“And the parched ground shall become a pool, and the thirsty land springs of water: in the habitation of dragons, where each lay, shall be grass with reeds and rushes.”

4. Isaiah 35:10 – Israel shall return and be restored as a nation.



“And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.”
