Prophecies of Isaiah 51 Isaiah 30:8 – Isaiah is to write the prophecies in a book.

- **1. Isaiah 51:1 The Messiah would be the Rock.**
 - "Hearken to me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the
 - LORD: look unto the rock whence ye are hewn, and to the hole of the pit whence ye are digged."

<u>1 Corinthians 10:4</u> "And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ."

2. Isaiah 51:3 The land of Israel will be restored.

"For the LORD shall comfort Zion: he will comfort all her waste places; and he will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the LORD; joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody."

3. Isaiah 51:6 God's word will last pass the destruction of the earth.

"Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath:
for the heavens shall vanish away like smoke, and the earth shall wax old like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner: but my salvation shall be for ever, and my righteousness shall not be abolished."

<u>Matthew 24:35</u> "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away."

<u>Hebrews 1:11-12</u> " They shall perish; but thou remainest; and they all shall wax old as doth a garment;

12 And as a vesture shalt thou fold them up, and they shall be changed: but thou art the same, and thy years shall not fail."


<u>2 Peter 3:10-12</u> "But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

11 Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, 12 Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?" <u>Revelation 6:14</u> And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places."

<u>Revelation 20:11</u> "And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them."

4. Isaiah 51:11 The Nation of Israel shall return to Zion.

* "Therefore the redeemed of the LORD shall return, and come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon their head: they shall obtain gladness and joy; and sorrow and mourning shall flee away." (Valley of the Dry Bones)
