

Prophecies of Isaiah 62

Isaiah 30:8 – Isaiah is to write the prophecies in a book.

Isaiah 62:4 The Messiah will restore the land of Israel and call it Beulah.



“Thou shalt no more be termed Forsaken; neither shall thy land any more be termed Desolate: but thou shalt be called Hephzibah, and thy land Beulah: for the LORD delighteth in thee, and thy land shall be married.”

Hephzibah means “My delight is in her.”

Beulah means “Married”.

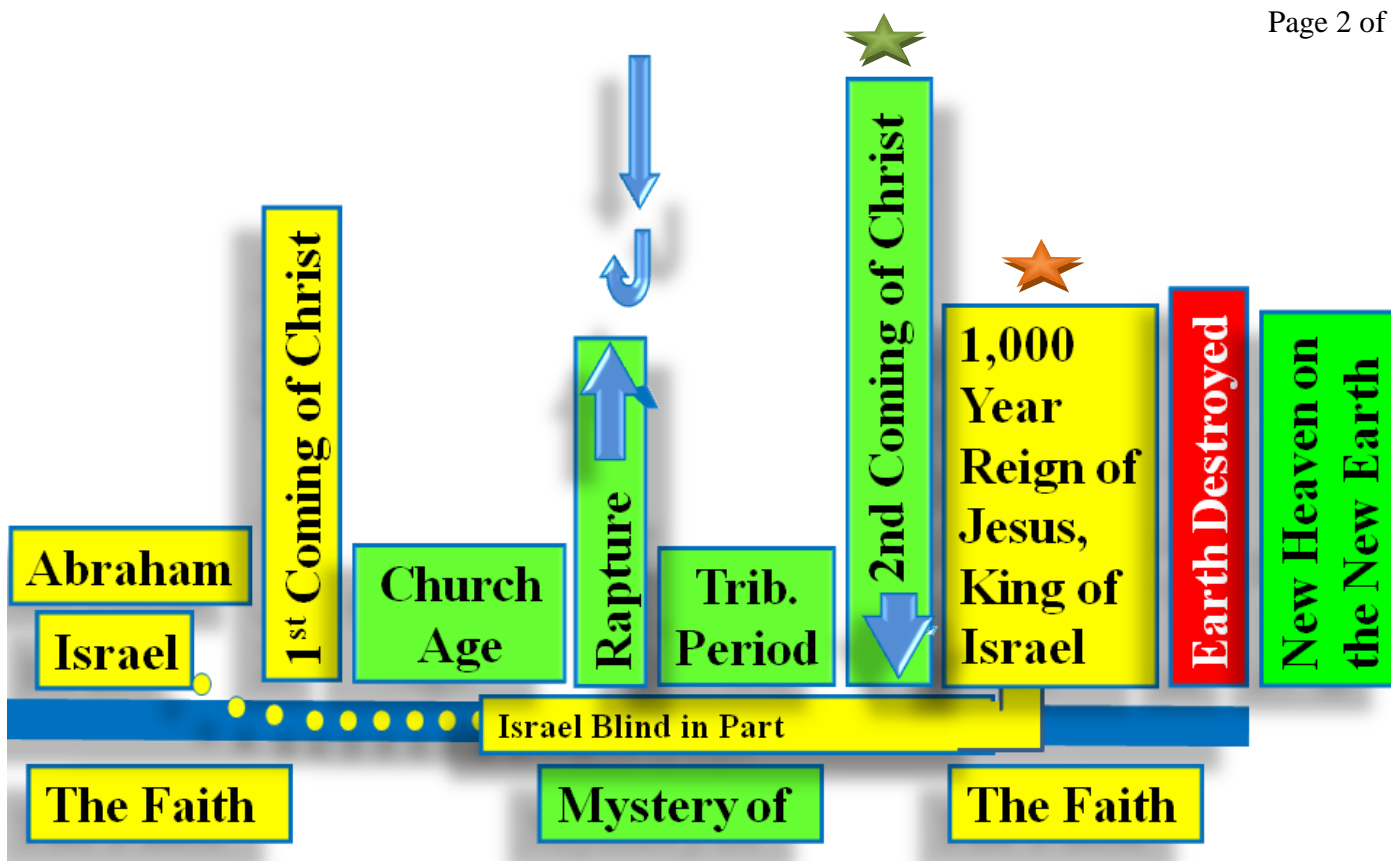
Isaiah 62:11-12 The Messiah shall come and restore the nation of Israel to its spiritual position.
