Prophecies of Isaiah 7

1. Isaiah 7:14 - The Messiah would be born of a virgin and would be called Immanuel, "God With Us."



Isaiah 7:14 "Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel."


<u>Matthew 1:21-23</u> "And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

- 2. Isaiah 7:15 The Messiah would have wisdom from His childhood.

<u>Luke 2:40</u> "And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the grace of God was upon him."
