- I. Lazarus, Mary and Martha. John 11:1
  - A. Lazarus was sick. John 11:1-2
    - 1. Mary and Martha sent word of Lazarus sickness to Jesus. John 11:3
- II. The purpose of Lazarus' sickness. John 11:4
  - A. The sickness is not unto death.
  - B. The sickness is to glorify God and Jesus.
- III. What is death?
  - A. Physical death.
  - B. Spiritual death.
- IV. What is physical death? Luke 16:19-21
  - A. Death of the body. Luke 16:22
    - 1. Death is no activity in the body, temporary or permanent.
    - 2. Death is separation of the soul and spirit from the body.
  - B. Death of the soul and spirit. Luke 16:23-24
    - 1. Death is torment in the flames of Hell (second death). Luke 16:23-24, Revelation 21:8, Revelation 20:14

- V. What does a soul look like?
  - A. Where were the bodies of the beggar and the rich man in Luke 16:23-24?
  - B. In Luke 16:23-24 was the description, which was given, of the bodies or of the souls of the beggar and the rich man?
- VI. For a saved person, the soul and spirit does not die when it is separated from the body. Luke 16:22, John 11:25-26
  - A. The body sleeps in the grave when it is separated from the soul and spirit. John 11:11-14
    - 1. The body will be raised (woke up) or changed at the Rapture. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17
  - B. "This sickness is not unto death." John 11:4
    - 1. For a saved person:
      - a. This accident is not unto death.
      - b. This abortion is not unto death.
      - c. This murder is not unto death.
      - d. This old age is not unto death.
