

John 11:11-16

- I. Lazarus is asleep. John 11:11
 - A. Jesus must wake him up. John 11:11
 - B. The disciples thought sleep was a rest. John 11:12-13
 - C. Jesus used the word sleep to mean death. John 11:14
 - 1. The sleep of death. Psalm 13:3, Luke 8:49-55
 - 2. Abuse of the Lord's Supper. 1 Corinthians 11:27-30
 - 3. Not all shall sleep. 1 Corinthians 15:51-52
 - 4. Sleep in Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18
 - 5. Those asleep shall wake up. 1 Thessalonians 5:9-11
- II. Lazarus will live again. John 11:11
 - A. The absence of Jesus at Lazarus' death: John 11:15
 - 1. Established the fact by man that Lazarus was dead.
 - 2. The presence of Jesus after Lazarus' death would give belief to the disciples. John 11:15
- III. To be where Lazarus was is to be in Judaea. John 11:7-8

- A. The raising of Lazarus was about three or four weeks before Jesus would be crucified. John 11:55.
 - 1. Beginning with John 12:1 there will be six days before Jesus is crucified.
 - 2. John chapter 12 to chapter 19 covers the six days before Jesus is crucified.
- IV. Thomas said Let us go and die with Jesus. John 11:16
 - A. Peter would die with Jesus but denied him 3 times and ran away at the cross.
 - B. Thomas would die with Jesus in Judaea (John 11:8) but ran away at the cross.
 - C. To die in a fight is one thing, but to surrender to die (suicide) is another thing.
 - 1. Jesus told his disciples not to defend or protect him. Matthew 26:50-56
