I. Lazarus in the grave four days. John 11:17-27

A. Four days was proof that Lazarus was indeed dead.

II. Bethany as about a half an hour walk from the Temple. John 11:18-19

A. Many of the Jews from Jerusalem were there:

1. To comfort Martha and Mary. John 11:19

2. To witness the resurrection of Lazarus. John 11:45-53

III. Martha met Jesus outside of town. John 11:20, 30

A. If thou hadst been here. John 11:21

1. Lazarus would not have died. John 11:21

B. But even now Jesus could do something. John 11:22

C. Lazarus will rise again. John 11:23

1. Martha said yes, in the last day. John 11:24

D. Jesus is the resurrection. John 11:25

1. A believer is still alive even though the body is dead. John 11:25

E. A believer will never die. John 11:26

1. Do you believe this? John 11:26

F. Martha believed that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God. John 11:27

IV. Jesus asks for Mary. John 11:28

A. Mary goes to Jesus. John 11:29-31

B. If thou hadst been here. John 11:32

1. Lazarus would not have died. John 11:32

C. Jesus wept. John 11:33-35

1. The attitude of the Jews. John 11:36-37
