

John 11:38-57

- I. Jesus goes to the grave. John 11:38
 - A. The grave was a cave with a stone upon it. John 11:38
 - B. Jesus said to remove the stone. John 11:39
 - C. Martha reminded Jesus that Lazarus has been dead four days. John 11:39
 - 1. If she would believe, she would see the glory of God. John 11:40
 - D. They took away the stone and Jesus prayed. John 11:41-42
 - E. Jesus calls for Lazarus to come out of the grave. John 11:43
 - F. Lazarus comes out of the grave (cave). John 11:44
 - 1. Bound with graveclothes hand and foot. John 11:44
 - 2. His face was bound with a napkin. John 11:44

Note: All the people that Jesus raised did not receive a resurrected body, but their bodies were revived. That is the reason for the graveclothes still on Lazarus. Their bodies will be raised after the resurrection of the body of Jesus.

- II. The graveclothes of Jesus. John 19:39-42
 - A. Peter & John saw the graveclothes of Jesus in the tomb. John 20:3-7

- B. Because of this we believe that when we are raptured, our clothes (graveclothes) will be left. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17
- C. Our clothing is symbolic of our death in sin. Genesis 3:6-7
- D. We are buried in our clothing.
- E. There will be a redemption of our body. Romans 8:23
- III. When we are raised. 1 Corinthians 15:51-52
 - A. We will have a resurrected body like that of Jesus. Philippians 3:20-21
 - 1. We will have resurrected clothing as Jesus did. John 21:15-16, 19-20
- IV. Jesus said, loose him. John 11:44
- V. Many of the Jews believed on Jesus and some did not. John 11:45-53
- VI. Jesus goes to Ephraim. John 11:54
- VII. The Passover was at hand. John 11:55-57
