


John 11:5-10

- I. Jesus loved Martha, and her sister, and Lazarus. John 11:5
 - A. Jesus loves me. Galatians 2:20
 - B. Jesus loves you. John 15:9
 - C. Jesus loves us. Revelation 1:5
- II. There would be a delay of over four days before Jesus would see them. John 11:6, 17.
 - A. Why didn't Jesus just speak the word and Lazarus could have been healed?
 - 1. Jesus healed the nobleman's son without going to him. John 4:46-53
 - 2. Jesus healed the centurion's servant without going to him. Matthew 8:5-13
 - B. Why did Jesus delay his return to Martha, Mary and Lazarus?
 - 1. So that the apostles might believe. John 11:15
 - 2. So that the faith of Martha and Mary's would grow. John 11:20-22
 - a. Their faith was a general faith. John 11:23-27



- 3. So that God and Jesus would be glorified. John 11:4
- III. Jesus tells his disciples that they are going to Judaea. John 11:6-7
 - A. Two days in Bethabara. John 1:28, John 10:40
 - B. His disciples warn him of the danger. John 11:8
 - 1. In the day there is no danger. John 11:9
 - 2. In the night there is danger. John 11:10
