- I. Six days before the Passover. John 12:1
 - A. This Passover is when Jesus will be crucified. John 19:14-18
 - 1. Jesus would be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. Matthew 12:39-40
 - 2. It was written. Luke 24:45-46
 - 3. The first three Feast of the Lord. Leviticus 23:4-11
 - a. Passover 14th day of the first month.
 - b. Unleavened Bread 15th day of the first month. (High Sabbath)
 - c. Firstfruits First day after the Sabbath following the Passover.
 - B. To set the days we start with the Resurrection and count backwards to the Passover then to the first day of the week with the Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem.
