- I. Jesus bore his cross to Golgotha. John 19:17
  - A. The place of a skull, called Golgotha or Calvary. Luke 23:33
- II. Jesus was crucified with two men one on each side of him. John 19:18
  - A. They were two thieves. Matthew 27:38
  - B. That the scripture would be fulfilled, "And he was numbered with the transgressors. Mark 15:28, Isaiah 53:12
- III. Pilate put a title on the cross. John 19:19
  - A. Jesus of Nazareth the King of the Jews. John 19:19
  - B. Written in Hebrew, Greek and Latin. John 19:20-22
- IV. The soldiers took his clothes. John 19:23
  - A. They cast lots for his coat. John 19:24
  - B. That the scripture would be fulfilled. Psalm 22:18
- V. Jesus entrusted his mother to John. John 19:25-27
- VI. Jesus said, "I Thirst." John 19:28-29
  - A. That the scripture would be fulfilled. Psalm 69:21
