    - 2. Everything is done according to the scriptures. 1 Corinthians 15:3-4
    - 3. Jesus was put in the tomb of Joseph of Arimathaea. Matthew 27:57-60
    - 4. According to the scriptures. Isaiah 53:9
- II. Nicodemus brought a mixture of myrrh and aloes. John 19:39
  - A. Who is Nicodemus?
    - 1. Ruler of the Jews. John 3:1-3

- 2. A Pharisee. John 7:47-52
- B. Why did Nicodemus bring a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about an hundred-pound weight? John 19:39-40
