I. Mary Magdalene goes to the tomb of Christ. John 20:1

A. She tells Peter and John. John 20:2

1. Someone moved the body to another tomb. John 20:2

II. Peter and John runs to the tomb. John 20:3-4

A. They see the linen clothes (graveclothes) and the napkin. John 20:5-7

III. The graveclothes. John 19:39-42

A. When Lazarus was raised with his graveclothes. John 11:44

Note: All the people that Jesus raised did not receive a resurrected body, but their bodies were revived. That is the reason for the graveclothes still on Lazarus. Their bodies will be raised after the resurrection of the body of Jesus.

B. Peter & John saw the graveclothes of Jesus in the tomb. John 20:5-7

C. Because of this we believe that when we are raptured, our clothes (graveclothes) will be left. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17

D. Our clothing is symbolic of our death in sin. Genesis 3:6-7

E. We are buried in our clothing.

F. There will be a redemption of our body. Romans 8:23

1. When we are raised. 1 Corinthians 15:51-52

**2. We will have a resurrected body like that of Jesus.
Philippians 3:20-21**

**G. We will have resurrected clothing as Jesus did.
John 20:15-16, 19-20**
