

## John 2:1-11 Water to Wine

**January 11, 2015** 

- I. How are we to study this event in the life of Jesus?
  - A. As to the symbols used in this event.
    - 1. Because Jesus treated the need of wine as a symbol of the shedding of his blood on the cross. John 2:3-4
  - B. As the first miracle of Jesus to reveal his glory. John 2:11
    - 1. There is much to learn in this event by faith as Mary told the servants to obey him. John 2:5
- II. The wedding. John 2:1
  - A. A man and a woman become one. Genesis 2:23-24
    - 1. Genesis 2:23-24 is quoted in Ephesians 5:30-32.
  - B. The wedding is about how the church can be married to Christ. Romans 7:4, 2 Corinthians 11:2
  - C. Mary, Jesus and his disciples were at the wedding. John 2:1-2
    - 1. Marriage is God's plan and not man's plan. Matthew 19:4-6
      - a. "Marriage is to be honorable among all men; and therefore is not by any to be entered into unadvisedly or lightly; but reverently, discreetly, advisedly, and in the fear of God."
- III. There was a need for wine at the wedding. John 2:3
  - A. Jesus uses wine symbolically as His blood to be shed on the cross. John 2:4, Matthew 26:27-29

- B. My hour is not yet come. John 2:4
  - 1. His hour would be his death on the cross. John 12:23, 27
  - 2. On the Feast of the Passover, His hour came. John 13:1
  - 3. Jesus would be raised on the third day. John 2:1
    - a. The sign of salvation. Matthew 12:39-40
- IV. This miracle will teach how we are saved by the blood of Jesus.
  - A. The miracle must be done God's way. John 2:5
  - B. Six waterpots of stone were used. John 2:6
    - 1. Six is symbolic of man.
      - a. 1 = unity; 2 = witness; 3 = trinity; 4 = world; 5 = division; 6 = man; 7 = perfect
    - 2. Water is symbolic of man's physical birth. John 3:5-7
    - 3. Waterpots of stone. John 2:6
      - a. Heart of stone. Ezekiel 11:19-20
    - 4. Manner of purifying... Man's way. John 2:6
      - a. Fill with water to the brim. John 2:7
      - b. All that man can do is not enough. Galatians 2:16
  - C. Told to draw out of the waterpots. John 2:8
    - 1. When did the water turn to wine?
    - 2. Each time they "drew the water." John 2:9
  - D. The act of faith, they drew the water not wine. Hebrew 11:6
  - E. Six waterpots (man) + faith in Jesus = 7 wine for redemption, salvation. Ephesians 1:7
  - F. Each soul remains lost (water) until we draw by faith, then the wine (blood of Jesus) brings salvation. Romans 10:8-11
- V. And his disciples believed. John 2:11
  - A. Will you believe & obey?
