I. Jesus in Samaria. John 4:5

A. All the Jews were taken out of Samaria. 2 Kings 18:9-11

1. People, who were not Jews, from five cities in Assyria were brought to live in Samaria. 2 Kings 17:24
2. A priest was sent to teach them the manner of God. 2 Kings 17:25-28

B. Why did Jesus go to Sychar? John 4:5

1. To take salvation to the Gentiles, the world. John 3:16
2. The promise is to the Jews (Abraham) and to the world (Jesus, the Seed). Galatians 3:16

C. What is common between the land and the well? John 4:5-6

1. Jacob's name changed to Israel. Genesis 32:28
2. Jacob's 12 sons become the 12 tribes of the nation Israel.

II. At Jacob's well, Jesus present the Gospel to a Samaritan (the world). John 4:6-7

A. Jesus was tired from his journey. John 4:6

- 1. Jesus as God experienced in the flesh our weakness. Hebrews 2:14-17**
- 2. Jesus reveals that He is our High priest touched with our weakness. Hebrews 4:14-16**

B. It was noon about 12 o'clock. John 4:6

C. A woman of Samaria came to draw water. John 4:7

- 1. The woman did not come to see Jesus. Isaiah 65:1**
 - a. Jesus was there to see the woman. Luke 19:10**

III. Jesus asks the woman to give him a drink of water. John 4:7

A. Jesus asked the woman to obey and serve him. John 4:7-8

- 1. Jesus asks each individual to obey and serve him. Luke 9:23**
