The Samaritan woman brings up the past, present and future to Jesus. Jesus ignores the past reveals the present and is the future.

I. The woman's attitude is based on the past. John 4:9

A. You can learn from the past, but do not live the past. Galatians 2:20

- 1. Your old man (past) is crucified. Romans 6:6**
- 2. Old things are passed away. 2 Corinthians 5:17**
- 3. You have a new life. Ephesians 4:22-24**

B. Jesus ignores the past. John 4:10

- 1. The knowledge of what God is doing is more important. John 4:10**
- 2. We are to know the time. Romans 13:11-13**
- 3. We are to know by the Holy Spirit. 1 Corinthians 2:11-12**

C. The woman could have living water by asking. John 4:10

- 1. The woman thought this living water could be received by works. John 4:11-12**
- 2. The living water is a gift. John 4:13-14**
 - a. The gift of God. Ephesians 2:8-9**

II. The woman wants what Jesus has offered. John 4:15

A. Jesus asks the woman to bring her husband. John 4:16

B. The woman hides the present. John 4:17

C. Jesus reveals the present. John 4:17-18

III. The woman's worship is based on the past. John 4:19-20

A. Jesus reveals true worship. John 4:21-24

IV. The woman looks to the future when the Messiah comes. John 4:25

A. Jesus is the future. John 4:26

V. The woman repents and tells others about Jesus. John 4:27-29
