



John 5:1-20

I. Jesus starts in Judea to reveal himself to the priest to be accepted as the Christ. Jesus returns to Judea three times to expose their abuse of the law and give them an opportunity to receive him. Acts 13:46

A. Travels of Jesus in John. John 1:11

- 1. In John 1:1-42 Jesus starts in Judea to reveal himself to his own and was rejected.**
- 2. In John 1:43-2:12 Jesus goes to Cana of Galilee to reveal his glory to his disciples.**
- 3. In John 2:13-3:36 Jesus goes to Judea to teach you must be born again and was rejected.**
- 4. In John 4:1-42 Jesus goes to Samaria to present the gospel to the Gentiles and they received him.**
- 5. In John 4:43-54 Jesus goes to Galilee and is accepted.**
- 6. In John 5:1-47 Jesus goes to Juda and they want to kill him.**
- 7. In John 6:1-7:9 Jesus goes to Galilee and feeds the five thousand.**
- 8. In John 7:10-20:31 Jesus goes to Juda and stays until he is crucified, buried and raised the third day.**
- 9. In John 21:1-25 Jesus appeared in Galilee to his disciples.**

II. Jesus goes to Juda to be received by the priest.

A. Feast in Jerusalem. John 5:1

- 1. It was the Sabbath. John 5:9**

B. Location: the pool of Bethesda. John 5:2

- 1. A place of healing only when the Angel stirred the water. John 5:3**
- 2. Only at a certain time when an Angel would appear. John 5:4**
- 3. Only one person could be healed, the first one in the water. The second and others that followed in the water would not be healed. John 5:4**

III. Man's effort is not enough. John 5:5-7

- A. The healing was there, but not available to all. John 5:7**

IV. Jesus heals the man. John 5:8-9

- A. Jesus tells the man to arise, take up his bed and walk. John 5:8**

V. Jesus has the man to break the laws of the Sabbath as interpreted by the priests. John 5:10-20

- A. The Jews wanted to know why the man was carrying his bed on the Sabbath. John 5:10-12**

- 1. The man did not know. John 5:13**
- 2. Jesus finds the man. John 5:14**
- 3. You can be worse. John 5:14, Matthew 12:43-45**

B. The Jews persecute Jesus. John 5:15-16

C. Jesus explains some things about the Sabbath. John 5:17-20

- 1. The Sabbath was made for man. Mark 2:27**
- 2. Jesus is the Lord of the Sabbath. Mark 2:28**
- 3. What type of work can be done on the Sabbath? Luke 6:9, 13:14-17**
 - a. Jesus must do the Father's work. John 5:17-20**
