A. Jesus saw them. John 6:5

III. Jesus wanted to feed them. John 6:5, Matthew 14:16, Mark 6:37, Luke 9:13

A. The disciples said it was not possible to feed them. Matthew 14:15, Mark 6:35-37, Luke 9:12-12

B. Jesus wanted to know how much bread they had. Mark. 6:38

1. Andrew had a lad with five barley loaves and two small fishes. John 6:8-9, Matthew 14:17, Mark 6:38, Luke 9:13

C. Jesus had everyone to sit down by companies. Mark 6:39-40, Luke 9:14-15

D. There were five thousand men, beside women and children. John 6:10, Mark 6:44, Luke 9:14, Matthew 14:21

E. Jesus gave the bread and fishes to the disciples for them to give to the people. John 6:11, Matthew 14:19, Mark 6:41, Luke 9:16

F. They all eat until they were full. John 6:12, Matthew 14:20, Mark 6:42, Luke 9:17

G. The disciples were to gather what was left. John 6:12-13, Mark 6:43
