I. Because of the miracle of feeding the 5,000:

A. They believed that Jesus is the prophet that should come. John 6:14

B. Moses prophesied that the Prophet would come. Deuteronomy 18:15-18

1. Peter repeated that prophecy. Acts 3:22-23

II. Jesus perceived. John 6:15

**A. Jesus knows the thoughts of all. John 2:24-25, Luke 6:6-10,
Hebrews 4:13-16**

III. They wanted to force Jesus to be a king. John 6:15

A. It was prophesied in Isaiah that Jesus would be a King. Isaiah 9:6-7

B. Gabriel told Mary that Jesus would be the King. Luke 1:30-33

C. Man wanted to help God, but not God's way or time. Romans 10:1-3

1. The Jewish nation must reject Jesus as King. John 1:11, Acts 13:46

**D. Jesus would be the King of Kings by his power. John 18:33-37,
Revelation 19:11-21, 20:1-6**
