- I. Jesus heals the Gadarene demoniac. Vs. 1-20
 - A. Living among the tombs was a man with an unclean spirit. Vs. 1-5
 - B. The man saw Jesus and went to him. Vs. 6
 - C. Jesus told the unclean spirit to leave the man. Vs. 7-8
 - D. There was a legion of spirits in the man. Vs. 9
 - 1. One Roman legion is 6,000 soldiers.
 - E. The unclean spirits recognized Jesus, and he gave them permission to go into a herd of 2,000 swine. Vs.10-12
 - F. All the swine ran down a steep place into the sea and died. Vs. 13
 - G. Those who fed the swine went into the city and country to tell what happened. Vs. 14
 - H. The man with the unclean spirits was now sitting, clothed, and in his right mind. Vs. 15
 - I. The people of the city were afraid and wanted Jesus to leave. Vs. 15-17
 - J. The man that had the legion of devils wanted to go with Jesus. Vs. 18
 - K. Jesus told him to go home to his friends and tell them what God did for him. Vs. 19
 - L. The man left and published in Decapolis what God did for him. Vs. 20
 - 1. Decapolis is a region of ten cities.

II. Jesus raises Jairus' daughter and heals a woman's blood disease.

Vs. 21-43

- A. Jairus, a ruler of a synagogue, asked Jesus to go to his house and heal his daughter. Vs. 21-23
 - 1. Jesus agreed to go with him, and a great crowd followed him. Vs. 24
- B. A woman with an issue of blood for twelve years believed if she could touch the clothes of Jesus she would be healed. Vs. 25-28
- C. She touched the clothes of Jesus and was healed immediately. Vs. 29
- D. Jesus wanted to know who touched him. Vs. 30-32
- E. The woman told Jesus what she had done and why she did it. Vs. 33
- F. Jesus told her that her faith had made her whole. Vs. 34
- G. Word came that Jairus' daughter had died. Vs. 35
- H. Jesus told Jairus not to be afraid, only believe. Vs. 36
- I. Jesus took Peter, James, and John with him to the house of Jairus. Vs. 37
- J. Jesus told those who were weeping and wailing that the daughter was not dead but sleeping. Vs. 38-40
- K. Jesus took the daughter by her hand and told her to get up. Vs. 41
- L. The daughter came alive, got up, walked and ate. Vs. 42-43
 - 1. The daughter was twelve years old. Vs. 42
