In chapter 14 we have a description of the 144,000 Jews, the three angels preaching the gospel and destruction of Babylon, and the two harvests.
Revelation 14:1 And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Zion, and with him an hundred forty <i>and</i> four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads.
John 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.
