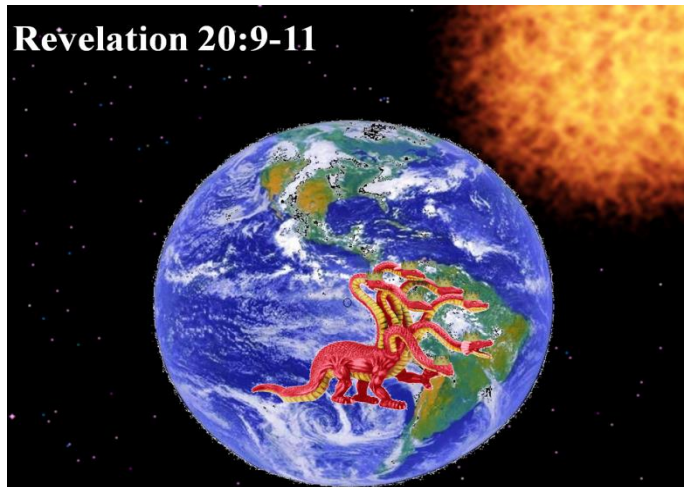
The end of the World and Great White Throne Judgment

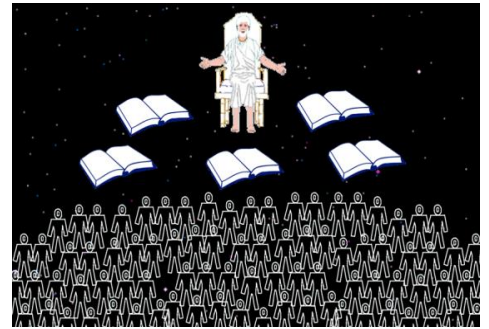
